What can you expect when you return to CDL?

- Our summer hours will be Mondays–Fridays 10am–6pm, Saturdays 10am–3pm, and closed on Sundays.
- The CDL shelves are ready and available for unlimited browsing.
- Public computers and printing will be available upstairs.
- The CDL Garage is open and waiting for you to Create, Design, and Learn all summer long!
- Friends Used Book Sales will begin Saturday, June 26 from 10am–2pm.
- Book donations will resume Monday, June 28.
- Magazine Exchange will resume on Monday, June 28.
- Study rooms and meeting rooms will be available to reserve with reduced capacities.
- The youth area will be open for browsing, but KidSpot, toys, and puzzles will not be available.
- According to the latest MDHHS order, masks while indoors are still required for those who are not fully vaccinated, including children ages 2–11. Some people may choose to wear masks even though they are not required for them. Courteous behavior regarding masking decisions is expected.
- Not ready for in-person browsing yet? Or, are you feeling unwell? Please call the library at 734-475-8732 x200 and we can place library materials into an overnight locker or make other arrangements for material pickup.
